Score Cards

New Player Registrations

We will be tightening our controls on the new player registrations from this season; due to more stringent policies at England Netball.

Teams **MUST** contact the Player Registration Co-Coordinator via mmnl@talktalk.net before the match is due to be played; even if it's on the same day, for a temporary league affiliation number.

A new registration card is to be completed as usual; and the affiliation number given to be added next to the player's name (if a number has not yet been given a copy of the email should be put in the box with the registration card)

It is the team's responsibility to ensure this is done; failure to request a temporary number will result in **all** players on both teams **and** both umpires being uninsured by England Netball for the duration of the game.

This player will be able to use the temporary number *three* times during the season. After this time they will need to have an official affiliation number from England Netball, please add this to the score card next to the player's name.

Again - failure to provide an affiliation number when you player next takes to the court will result in **all** players on both teams **and** both umpires being uninsured by England Netball for the duration of the game.

Please check with your player that they haven't already played for another team under a temporary number this season, as this will still count as part of their 3 free sessions.

If you have any queries about this please contact your Divisional Rep.

There are a few new teams in the league this season and a few that have changed leadership so below is a copy of our current score card; please take a few moments to see how we would like them to be completed; if you already do this, thank you – and keep up the good work!

Match – Your team name v the opposition team name as they appear on the fixtures sheet.

Division & Date - as appropriate.

Players Names – Please print the player's full name as they appear on the team registration form. Please draw a line before adding any players registered during the season or on the night.

Captains – This box must **only** completed at the end of the match once the scores have been agreed between captains and umpires. Please print names rather than sign.

Umpires - This box must **only** be completed at the end of the match once the scores have been agreed between captains and umpires. Please print names rather than sign.

Player of the Match – Please make sure your players full name is in this box; if it is not it may affect their chance of winning player of the season!

Finally don't forget to put your card in the appropriate numbered box in the club house after your match.

ROLE OF DIVISIONAL REPS MMNL (2010)

- ◆ To be responsible for the smooth running of their division.
- ◆ To support new teams with settling into the league (including paperwork).
- ◆ To be responsible for disseminating all league and other information to team secretaries and players.
- ◆ To encourage all teams in their division, to take an active role in all rallies and fundraising events.
- ◆ To encourage teams to send in paperwork on time
- ◆ To collect and check score cards on a weekly basis.
- ◆ To record each score, player of the match and any other information as appropriate and inform the Results Secretary of the result of the game, within 36hrs. If sick or on annual leave to delegate this and the collection and checking of score cards to another person and the Results Secretary
- ◆ To check that all players and umpires are registered with MMNL and England Netball.
- ◆ To inform the Results Secretary of all new registrations
- ◆ To be the named contact for the teams in their division with regard to the cancellation of matches due to adverse weather or other specific conditions.
- ◆ To re-arrange any cancelled fixtures as appropriate.
- ◆ To ensure the courts are kept clean and tidy and report any specific incidents which violate this.
- ◆ To liaise with the other divisional rep on your night to make arrangements for turning off court lights and lock the gates at the end of late matches or delegate a named person to do so (a committee member).
- ◆ To report all incidents or problems at committee meeting or if urgent to chairperson or vice chairperson
- ◆ To ensure all accidents or injuries that cause a player to retire from the game are reported on an accident form to the committee.

Refer to Committee Contact list if you have any queries.

Registering Umpires

If you are using an umpire that is not on the current MMNL Umpiring list please make sure you download a new umpire registration from the website www.mmnl.info and get them to complete the form before the match commences.

Umpires for Premier & Division 1 games will need to be assessed So it will not be possible to register them on the night.
